At the urging of young student Scott Burdick, Richard Schmid entered the historic P&C mansion in the early 80's. There he encountered a group of young, very talented hopeful artists who were trying to swim upstream against a current of abstract expressionism.

They wanted to be full-time artists. They wanted to work realistically, and they wanted to paint from the model, which at the time was shunned by the abstract school. Their goals met an already successful Richard Schmid's strengths and a wonderful relationship followed. More than just sharing technical skills, Richard mentored them and by action and encouragement sought to instill the discipline and meeting of challenges it would take to build a career in art.

This relationship and the development of lifelong friendships also changed Richard's life in a profound way. From that time on, he dedicated himself to being more than an accomplished painter. He strove to reach out and share his knowledge with the art community. He did this with such passion that he is now recognized as perhaps the most important American artist/teacher of the late 20th - early 21st century. Through books such as *Alla Prima* and working directly with students and artist alike his influence cannot be overstated.

Richard's presence at the Palette & Chisel became profound, too. During his P&C presidency he helped create new enthusiasm, financial stability and membership levels. His legacy and efforts can still be felt today. In fact, often an out-of-state artist guest or teacher will appear with the quest to "paint where Richard Schmid painted." Who could ask for a better endorsement?

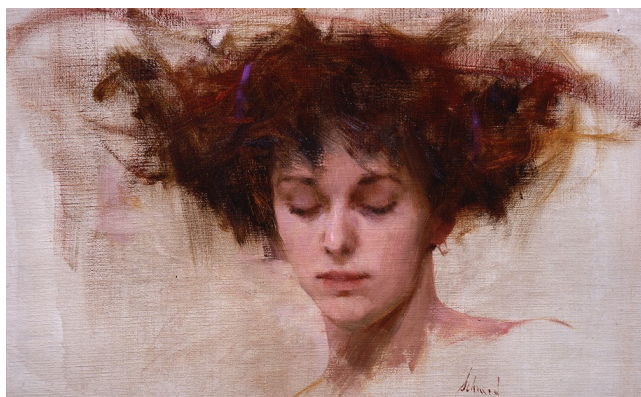

Travel

Two major airports serve the Chicago area: Chicago Midway International Airport (MDW) and O'Hare International Airport (ORD). Both airports are similar distances to the Claridge House Hotel, Talbott Autograph Hotel and the Palette & Chisel Academy of Fine Arts- all conveniently located in the Lincoln Park neighborhood.

Chicago O'Hare (ORD)

O'Hare International Airport offers a variety of transportation options to and from the city, including public transit, ridesharing services, taxis, and private car services.

Public Transportation

The CTA Blue Line provides 24/7 service to downtown Chicago, with an approximate travel time of 45 minutes. The Blue Line station is conveniently located at the airport.

O'Hare Rideshare & Taxis

There are taxi stands at the lower-level curbside (outside of baggage claim) at each terminal. Loading zones for rideshare services are on the upper level of Terminal 2.

Midway International Airport (MDW)

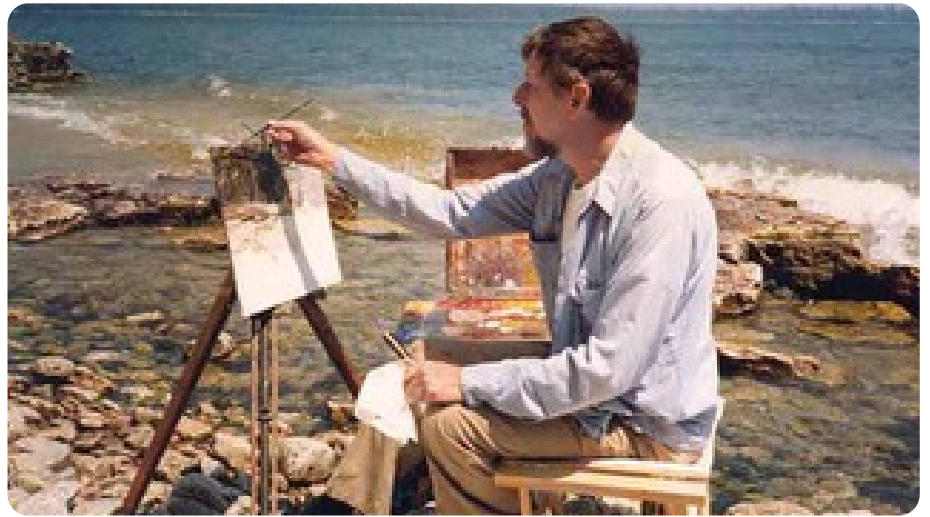
There are many ways passengers can get to and from Midway International Airport, including public transit, taxis, ridesharing services, and shuttles.

Midway - Public Transportation

The CTA Orange Line provides service to downtown Chicago, with an approximate travel time of 30 minutes. The Orange Line station is conveniently located just east of the terminal at the Midway Transportation Center and is connected to the airport via an enclosed walkway. Follow the signs in the airport that read "CTA Trains" or "Trains to City."

Midway - Rideshare & Taxis

There are taxi stands at the lower-level curbside (outside of baggage claim) at the terminals. Loading zones for rideshare services are on the lower level outside baggage claim, Doors 2-4.
